



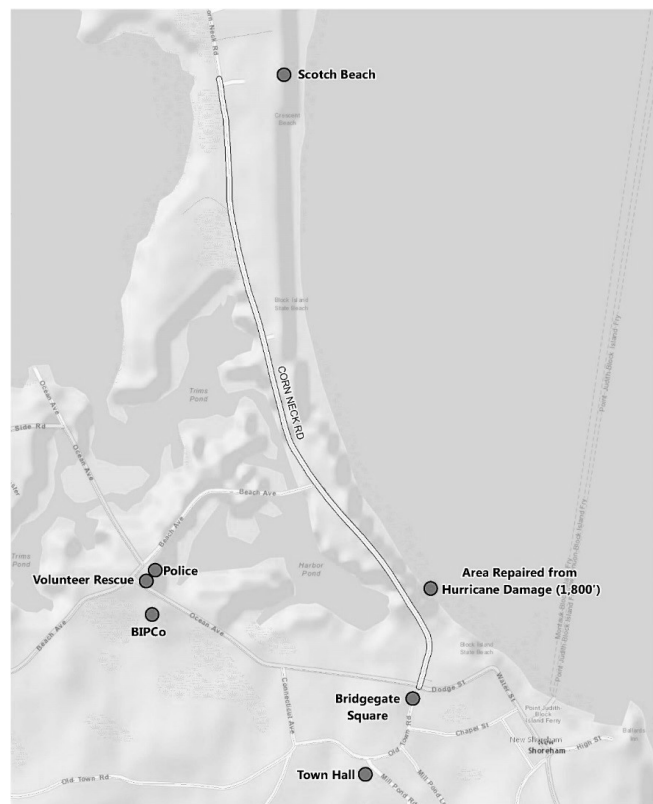
Public Open Meeting Corn Neck Road

April 19, 2017

Bridgeway Square becomes flooded as the storm runoff overwhelms the drainage system, and the Scotch Beach access point funnels the storm surge from the beach across Corn Neck Road. The Town has hired VHB to conduct a planning study which will focus on long-term alternatives for this vulnerable stretch of Corn Neck Road between Scotch Beach and Bridgeway Square to mitigate the impacts from storm surge and sea level rise.

Proposed Timeline for Corn Neck Road Study

- » **April:** Public Open Meeting
- » **May:** Team review of project alternatives, and compile plan
- » **June:** Planning Board to review preliminary findings
- » **July 12:** Draft plan and design alternatives presented at a Planning Board meeting
- » **August 9:** Final plan and design alternatives presented at a Planning Board meeting
